Covid-19 testing can be obtained locally by calling your private provider and they can send an order for lab testing. If you **do not have a medical provider**, **please call 304-598-6000 option 4** to speak to a nurse. See guidelines below for who should be tested. Please call this number, **304-598-6000 option 4**, **BEFORE** going to the hospital for testing. They will tell you when and if you need be tested. Please help us keep our doctor offices and hospitals safe.

If you are a close contact of someone with COVID-19 or have recently traveled to a community where there is ongoing spread of COVID-19 and develop <u>symptoms of COVID-19</u>, call your healthcare provider and tell them about your symptoms and your exposure. They will decide whether you need to be tested. Currently there is no treatment for COVID-19 and people who are mildly ill may be able to isolate and care for themselves at home.

The symptom of COVID-19 which may appear 2-14 days after exposure are:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath

If you are very sick get medical attention immediately

If you are sick with COVID-19 or suspect you are infected with the virus that causes COVID-19, you should take steps, https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/if-you-are-sick/index.html, to help prevent the disease from spreading to people in your home and community.
